1997	<i>Mama</i>	Herself	movie by Veronique Patte Doumbé from Cameroon with Miriam Makeba and her grand daughter Zenzi Lee in exile, on journey and at home in Southafrica
1996	<i>When We Were Kings</i>	Herself	documentary movie by Leon Gast about the preliminaries of the world championship fight Ali-Foreman in Kinshaza, Zaire in 1974; with Muhammad Ali, George Foreman, Norman Mailer and many others
1995	<i>Christmas At The Vatican</i>	Herself	TV-film (by whom ?) on her private audience with Pope John Paul II. and her christmas performance at the Vatican
1992	<i>Sarafina</i>	Angelina	musical documentary movie by Darrell James Roodt about the brave township children in South Africa; with Whoopi Goldberg, Lelethi Khumalo
1991	<i>The Bill Cosby Show</i>	Herself	Episode Nb. 186: "Olivia Comes Out Of The Closet"
1990	<i>The Frontline Festival</i>	Herself	no details to be found where and by whom this concert movie was shot; besides Miriam Makeba, Johnny Clegg was on the festival bill
1989	<i>Voices Of Sarafina</i>	Angelina ?	musical documentary movie by Nigel Noble about the brave township children in South Africa; with Lelethi Khumalo and others
1987	<i>Exiles</i>	Herself	no details to be found on this documentary film by Faith Isikapere

1987	<i>Graceland</i>	Herself	documentary movie by Richard McLaren about the two Graceland tour concerts in Harare, Zimbabwe with Paul Simon, Hugh Masekela and Ladysmith Black Mambazo (fortunately the movie was shot before Miriam Makeba injured both her ankles during that tour)
19 ??	<i>Bongo Man</i>	Herself	musical documentary movie by Steven Paul; with Jimmy Cliff, Bob Marley and other acts of Reggae music
1962-67	<i>US TV-Shows</i>	Herself	The Ed Sullivan Show (1962 / 65 / 67), The Hollywood Palace (1964 / 65), Hootenanny (1963)
1956/59	<i>Come Back Africa</i>	Herself	movie by Lionel Rogosin about the life conditions of black people under the South African Apartheid in the 1950s (According to one source work on the movie was begun in 1956 but it is not said when it was finished. In 1959 it was taken to the public in Europe and from there to the world. So usually 1959 is given as the release year)
1955 ?	<i>Have You Seen Drum Recently?</i>	Herself	documentary movie by Jürgen Schadeberg about the famous South African print magazine "Drum" in the 1950s ("Drum" had Miriam Makeba on the front cover of one issue in 1955; have a look into the gallery)
